JANE BLANCHARD: The City would like to send out our deepest condolences to the Blanchard and the Woody family. Jane Blanchard passed away on September 19, 2024. Her funeral was September 27, 2024 at Scott's funeral home Jane Blanchard was first elected as a Councilmember on April 19, 1984 and ended her career with the City of Liverpool around May 8, 2010. During the 26 years with the City of Liverpool Jane was a Council Member, Mayor Pro Tem, and Treasurer. Jane will truly be missed.

CITY COUNCIL: The new tax rate was passed at the September Council meeting. The tax rate that was passed will raise more taxes for maintenance and operations than last year's tax rate. The tax rate will effectively be raised by 7% and will raise taxes for maintenance and operations on a \$100,000 home by approximately \$7.6264. The City will evaluate the roads and rate them to see which roads need to be done first.

WATER PLANT: We had the manufacturer of the arsenic removal system look at the unit, and we are waiting for the test results to come back to see where we are on the arsenic levels.
